### **RULES & REGULATIONS**

- 1. Only registered players of the TTFI for the year 2022 can participate in the Championships;
- 2. All the matches will be played in accordance with the rules and regulations for Regional Championship as adopted by TTFI;
- 3. The Youth Boys & Girls (U-19) events open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2004;
- 4. The Youth Boys & Girls (U-17 Junior) events open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2006
- 5. The Youth Boys & Girls (U-15 Sub Junior) events are open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2008
- 6. The Youth Boys & Girls (U-13 Cadet) events are open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2010
- 7. The Youth Boys & Girls (U-11) events open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2012;
- 8. For evidence of age, players should bring Original Date of Birth Certificate issued by Municipal Corporation/school so that it could be verified, if required to do so:
- 9. All players will have to make their own arrangement for Boarding/Lodging;
- 10. The decision of Tournament Committee shall be final in all matters concerned with the Championships;
- 11. The Tentative Schedule will be as follows:

23/24/25 January, 2023 - U11/U13/U15 Boys and Girls 24/25/26 January, 2023 - U13/U15/U17 Boys and Girls

25/26/27/28 January, 2023 - U17/U19 (Boys and Girls ), Men, Women

#### Mixed Doubles event will start on 26th Morning

(Please note that this is only a tentative schedule and CM has the final authority to change the schedule based on the final entries in consultation with OC)

- 12. Entries close at 12 Noon on 15<sup>th</sup> January, for Institutions and at 12 Noon on 17<sup>th</sup> January, for the State Associations
- 13. DRAW FOR FIRST STAGE OF ALL EVENTS AT 15:00 Hrs on 21st January, 2023 at Venue
- 14. DRAW FOR SEEDED PLAYERS AT 18:00 Hrs on 22<sup>nd</sup> January, 2023 at Venue

15. The maximum number of entries which an affiliated unit is allowed is as per the TTFI Guidelines. Men/Women – 5 Entries with normal entry fee and additions 5 entries with extra entry fees For Institutions – 2 Entries with normal entry fee and additional 3 entries with extra entry fees Other events- 4 Entries with normal entry fee and additional 4 entries with extra entry fees We are introducing the event Mixed Doubles in National Ranking Tournaments on an experimental basis to groom the pairs on pathway to 2024 Olympics. The maximum entries per state are restricted to two. Institutions are eligible to send only one entry in Mixed Doubles. We are also allowing the players to pair with players of other states. However such entries should come from both the states. Players who are under the age of 17 are not eligible to participate in the event, unless they are ranked within top 16 in Men and women or ranked within top 8 in the U 19 category or they are in the top 5 in their respective states in Men/Women

TTFI can field wild card entries (max 32) in each event and they will be treated as extra entries with the fees applicable for the event.

#### 16. ITTF/TTFI approved tables and balls will be used for the Championships

- 17. All official Communication/Draw shall be displayed at the venue on 22<sup>nd</sup> January,2023 and that alone shall be the official communication in all respects. This Championship will be treated as Ranking Tournament and Points shall be awarded as per TTFI guidelines.
- 18. **On Line Entries**: Entries have to be submitted on line in our web site ttfi.org on the event page. Each State Association/Institution has already been provided with a Username and Password, which may be used to log in to the Online Entry System No entries will be accepted through mail or any other communication. No entries can be permitted after the deadline.
- 19. With regard to any clarification regarding online entries, States/Institutions may kindly contact our Federation office at: domesticevent@ttfi.org
- 20. All the participant players should have registered with TTFI. Entries of unregistered players will not be accepted. Players, who are already registered with TTFI, should pay a registration fee of Rs 500/- for the year 2022. Players who are registering for the first time should pay a Registration fee of Rs 1000/- This may be paid alongwith the entry fees in the first tournament they play in the calendar year or pay in cash at the venue to the Organisers. The Registration forms should be submitted to the Competition Manager/Referee at the Venue. All Youth category( U 19 Juniors) players should submit their Date of Birth Certificates and keep originals in possession for verification.
- 21. Transfer of players from one state to another is allowed only before the start of the season. Once registered with a particular State, the players will not be given any transfer during the Season
- 22. The entry fee will be as follows

First five entries in Men, Women : Rs. 900/- each
First four entries in U-19 , U 17 : Rs. 800/- each
First four entries in U-15, U-13 : Rs. 700/- each
First four entries in U - 11 ; Rs 600/- each
Mixed Doubles : Rs. 1800/- per pair

23. State Associations are allowed to enter extra entries as per clause 15 above. The entry fee for extra entries will be as follows:-

Seniors/U19/U17 - Rs 3500/-U 15/U13 - Rs 2500/-U 11 - Rs 1500/- 24. Payment of Entry Fees: on 17th January, after closure of entries, Federation office will raise an invoice to the respective associations/Institutions with regard to the payment of entry fees for all the players participating from the respective State Associations/Institutions. On receipt of the invoice the respective state Association/Institutions may transfer the amount by NEFT to the account of the organizers, which is furnished below. No entry fee may be send to TTFI office.

#### 25. SPORT CANCELLATION/CHANGE IN NOMINATIONS

Cancellation of participation is possible till 12:00 Noon of 20<sup>th</sup> January,2023 After this deadline, the penalty policy will apply and no changes will be accepted on players' entries and such players will be deducted with 20 points from the ranking. In case cancellation is not possible through the online system, due to some reasons, the same may be intimated to the Competition Manager before the deadline. However the entry fees for all entries as on the date of closure of entries (17<sup>th</sup> Jan) has to be paid to the organizers

#### 28. PLAYING SYSTEM

As per the decision of the AGM. Men Singles top 16 Players and for the rest of the events top 8 Players will be directly drawn to the Main Draw. The rest of the players will be divided into groups of 3 or 4. In all the events one player qualify from the Groups to the Main Draw. Mixed Doubles event will be held on knock out basis. The draw will be done by the Referee under the supervision of the Competition Manager/Technical Committee.

#### 29. PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES

Athletes are expected to attend the following promotional activities:

- Opening Ceremony
- Media interviews
- Award Ceremonies (in full tracksuit and sport shoes)

Failure to participate in promotional activities may result in loss of prize money and medals or both.
