RULES & REGULATIONS

1. ENTRY FEES

A sum of Rs.3000/- is payable to the Federation by each Association/Institution towards entry fee for team events . There is no additional entry fee for YBS U19/YGS U 19 Singles/Doubles for the players who are part of the State Team for the respective Events.

Entry fees will be charged as follows for the Junior Singles _ U 17 Events .

Entry fee for YBS U17/YGS U 17 : Rs 800/- per player each for participating in the Singles/Doubles Events

2. System of Play:-

a) Team Events (Youth U 19)

The Regulations for the competitions for (Youth Events) Boy's & Girl's Team Event will be conducted on New Swaythling Cup basis. Each team will consist of minimum 3 players and maximum of 4 players. The team events will be best of 5 singles. All individual matches in the Team events will be determined by the best of 5 Games.

Order of Play shall be:

A Vs X

B Vs Y

C Vs Z

A Vs Y

B Vs X

Team events will be conducted in two stages. In the first stage all teams will be divided in groups of 3 or 4 teams and they play the league matches. Two teams from each group qualify to the second stage which will be held on a knock out basis to decide the Winners. There will not be any match for positions 3 and 4.

3. Events

- a) The following events will be conducted:
- 1. Youth Boys Team Championships Under-19
- 2. Youth Girls Team Championships Under-19
- 3. Youth Boys Singles Under 19
- 4. Youth Boys' Doubles Under 19
- 5. Youth Girls Singles Under 19
- 6, Youth Girls' Doubles Under19

- 7. Youth Boys Singles Under 17
- 8. Youth Boys Doubles Under 17
- 9. Youth Girls Singles Under 17
- 10. Youth Girls Doubles Under 17

All the singles events will be played in two stages:

Stage-I: All the players (except the top-eight ranked players in YBS U19, YGS U19, YBS U17, YGS U17)) will be divided into groups of 3 or 4 players in each group. They will play one another in a round-robin league format to determine the order of position in each group. All the group league matches will be of best of five games.

Stage-II: Players finishing in the first position in each group, and the top-eight ranked players in the YBS U19, YGS U19, YBS U17, YGS U17 will play according to the single knockout system. All the Stage II matches will be of best of five games, except the following rounds which will be played in best of seven games.

Quarterfinals onwards in YBS U17, YGS U17;

Pre-quarterfinals onwards in YBS U19, YGS U 19.

b) The schedule of play is planned as below, and may be altered, if necessary.

i) Youth Girls Singles Under 17 & 19

8th to 11th February, 2023

ii) Youth Boys Singles Under 17 & 19

13th to 16th February, 2023

Girls under 17 & 19 should report on 7th February and the Boys Under 17 & 19 should report on 12th February, 2023

4. Hospitality Charges:

Each state association will pay a sum of Rs.400/- per day for each player, one manager, one coach towards hospitality Charges and the maximum people eligible for subsidized hospitality are 20, including one manager and one coach. The hospitality charges for additional/ manager/coach would be Rs. 750 per pax, per day.

Hospitality will include:

- a) Accommodation at a place provided by the host association, and Boarding for Girls from Lunch on 7th February to Breakfast on 12th February. Boarding for Boys from Lunch 12th February to Breakfast on 17th February. 2023
- b) Boarding shall include Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner. All other charges levied will be extra and to be borne by the participants.
- 5. If the accommodation provided is far away and more than a kilometer, the hosts will make transport from Hotel to Stadium and back.
- 6. There may be three sessions of play possible every day.

7. Entitlement of entries:

Each state association can send a maximum one team each in Youth Boys U 19 Team Event, Youth Girls U 19 Team Event, Four entries each in YBS U 19, YGS U 19, YBS U 17, YGS U 19, . Two entries each in YBD U 19, YGD U 19, YBD U 17, YGD U 17

Extra Entries: Each state association is entitled to FOUR extra entries in each of the categories (except team events and Doubles)..

The Extra Entry fee will be Rs. 4000/- per entry in Youth Girls/Boys Under-17, while it will be Rs 6000/- per entry in Youth Girls/Boys Under-19.

TTFI can consider 32 wild card entries, if and when required.

- 8. All the events will be held under the rules & regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation and as adopted by the Table Tennis Federation of India.
- 9. STAG Americas Tables and STAG balls will be used in the Championships.
- 10.. The closing date for receipt of entries online is 31st January, 2023
- 11. Open draws will be held at Venue on 7th February, 2023 for the Girls events and on 12th February, 2023 for the Boys events, commencing at 10 a.m.. The Technical Committee will conduct the draws.
- 12 Entries will be accepted only through an affiliated unit of the Table Tennis Federation of India. Direct entries from individual players will not be entertained.
- 13. All the associations/institutions will inform the Organizing Secretary at least 10 days before the commencement of the championships the date, time and the mode of transport by which their teams will be arriving at Chennai
- 14. Gluing and smoking is not allowed inside the hall.
- 15. Participation certificates will be issued to all the participants of the 84th Junior & Youth National Table Tennis Championships-2022. Those who make it to the medal rounds will get merit certificates.

the names in the online portal.

Youth Boys & Youth Girls Events (Under 19)

These events are open to only those players who are born on or after 01.01.2004

Junior Boys & Junior Girls Events (Under 17)

These events are open to only those players who are born on or after 01.01.2006.

Age Eligibility The respective affiliated units shall certify the correctness of the date of birth of each

entrant

Registration Form: and all players should submit their registration form (if not submitted earlier to TTFI this

year) in the prescribed format, duly attested by the Head of the Institution/School in which the player is studying and counter-signed by the respective State Association secretary. The copy of the birth certificate should also be attested by the State Secretary. In case the birth registration is not done within a year with the authorities

concerned, a court order has to be obtained.

INFORMATION FOR PLAYERS

By entering the event, players agree to abide by all TTFI rules and regulations, including that of the Organizing Committee. All associations and individual players agree to be under the auspices of the TTFI and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, internet, webcasting, motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. Participants release all rights or rights held by their agents/sponsors in all matters relating to the above. A participant's refusal to any of the above clauses may attract suspension or dismissal from the competition.
