RULES & REGULATIONS

1. ENTRY FEES

- (a) A sum of Rs.3000/- is payable to the Federation by each Association/Institution towards entry fee for team event.
- (b) Entry Fees for Singles/Doubles:

For Institutions (applicable to Institutions who are not eligible to play in Team events)

Singles: Rs 900/- per entry (Max Two entries)

Doubles: Rs 1800/- per pair (Max one entry in MD and WD and two entries in MXD)

- (c) Each Association shall pay a sum of Rs.450/- for team players, Manager and the Coach per day per person towards boarding and lodging charges. For extra Coach/Manager @ Rs.750/- per day per head will be charged.(Subsidised Hospitality is for 12 persons, Men 5, Women 5, One Manager, One Coach)
- (d) The entry fee is payable along with the entry and is not refundable. The entry fee are to be remitted to TTFI by NEFT BANK TRANSFER and the Hospitality Charges are to remitted to the organizing committee by Bank Transfer to the account of Meghalaya Table Tennis Association,

2. System of Play:

(a) Team Events

The Regulations for the competitions for Men's & Women's Team event will be as follows. The team events will be best of 5 singles. All individual matches in the team events will be determined by the best of 5 Games.

Order of play shall be

A Vs X

B Vs Y

 $C \ Vs \ Z$

A Vs Y

B Vs X

The competition shall be conducted in two stages

Stage I All the Teams shall be drawn into Eight Groups as per the last National Position & play one another in a Round Robin League System to determine the position in each group.

Stage II In the second stage, the No. 1 & No. 2 Teams of these Eight Groups shall play by progressive knock out system, to determine the 1 to 16 positions.

(b) Individual Events

All the singles events shall be played in two stages

- Stage I In the first stage, all the players except 1- 16 classified players in Men and 1-8 classified Players in Women, shall be divided into groups, with 3 or 4 players in each group. They shall play one another in a Round Robin League System to determine an order of position in each group. All the Group league matches will be best of five games. One player from each group qualify to the Main Draw
- Stage II In the second stage, the winners from each groups &Ranked Players 1- 16 for Men and 1-8 for Women, shall play according to single knock out system. All matches in stage II shall be best of five games throughout.
- (C) All Doubles events will be best of five games.

All Doubles events will also carry prize money in the Senior National Championships. However the entries are restricted as per the normal quota of 2 pairs each for Men's and Women's Doubles and four pairs for mixed doubles applicable for State Associations. For Institutions, the quota allowed is One Entry each for Men's and Women's Doubles and two entries for Mixed Doubles.

- 3. The schedule of play is planned as below and may be altered if found necessary.
 - i) Team Championships

18 – 21 April,2022

ii) Individual Events

21 – 25 April, 2022

- 4 The following shall be entitled to subsidized hospitality.
 - (A) Association/Institution competing in Men's Team & Women's Team Championships.

5Persons maximum for Men's Team Championships (Minimum 3)

- 5 Persons maximum for Women's Team Championships (Minimum 3)
- 1 Manager, 1 Coach

Total not to exceed 12 persons

- (B) Association competing in one event only:
 - 5 persons maximum in Men's Team Plus one coach/manager
 - 5 persons maximum in Women's Team Plus one coach/manager
- 5. . Hospitality will include:
 - a) Accommodation at a place provided by the Host Association and Boarding from Lunch of 17th April upto to the breakfast on 26th April, 2022
 - b) Boarding shall include Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner. All other Charges will be extra and shall be borne by the participants
 - c) Hospitality will be extended only to the States and not to any Institution
- 6. If the accommodation place is far away more than 1 KM, the host Association will provide necessary transport from Hotel to Stadium and back.
- 7. There may be Three Sessions of play every day.

- 8. A copy of all the draws together with daily schedules of matches shall be handed over to the Manager/Coach of the teams on arrival which shall serve as the only official intimation to the competitors regarding the programme and time of play. All authentic information regarding the Championships can be had from the Competition Manager/Referee of the Championships. Manager's Meeting will be held on 17th April evening at 2000 Hrs at the venue. No alterations to the entries will be permitted in the Managers' Meeting except for replacement of players who are withdrawing due to illness
- 9. Competitors Badges will be issued to the players for admission into the tournament Hall.
- 10. All Umpiring will be in English.
- 11. All events will be held under the Rules & appropriate Regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation as adopted by the Table Tennis Federation of India.
- 12. The STAG 40 + Balls and STAG America Tables will be used in the Championships
- 13.. The order of play will not be altered even if the Captains mutually agree, unless it has the final approval and consent of the Referee. The Captains of the teams scheduled to play at a particular time, shall report to the Referee or his appointed Deputy at least thirty minutes before the time fixed for their matches. A team not present at the scheduled time for its match is liable to concede a walk over to its opponents.
- 14. The closing date for receipt of entries online is 4th April, 2022. Alterations/Deletions to the entries will be allowed till 6th April. However no addition in entries will be accepted after the deadline4thApril (except for withdrawals due to illness/injury)
- 15. The draws will be held on 13th April, 2022 commencing at 10 A.M. at New Delhi. Each Association from which entries have been received is entitled to be represented by one person duly authorized by the Association concerned. The Technical Committee will conduct the Draws.
- 16. Entries will be accepted only through Affiliated Associations / Institutions of the Table Tennis Federation of India. Direct entries from individual players will not be accepted.
- 17. Entries will not be accepted from such of those Association / Institutions who have not:
 - a) Complied with the Rules and Regulations of TTFI in respect of affiliation fee in the conduct of the open Tournaments
 - b)Paid all the arrears and complied with the decisions of the General Council of the TTFI held in previous years
- 18. All Associations / Institutions will intimate to the Organizing Secretary/General Convener at least 10 days before the commencement of the Championships, the date, time and Train/Bus by which they will be reaching Shillong.
- 19. Glueing and smoking is not allowed inside the hall.
- 20. Participation Certificates will be given to all the participants in the 83rdSenior National & Inter State Table Tennis Championships 2021.

IMPORTANT REGULATIONS REGARDING ELIGIBLE ENTRIES

ENTRIES

Every Association/Institution (Since No institution has come forward to host the Inter Institutional championships during 2020 and 2021, we are considering the last available results of the Inter Institutional championships and are permitting PSPB and Railways team to participate in the both Men and Women Team Championships) shall be permitted to send a maximum of five entries each in Men & Women events. Players taking part in team match must be dressed uniformly otherwise they will not be allowed to play in the match.

Those Institutions which have not qualified for the team events may nominate only two entries (i.e. two men & two women) in Single Events, One Entry each in Men's & Women's Doubles Events & Two Entries in Mixed Doubles. In Doubles Institutions may enter different players from Singles if it is necessary. No other entries will be allowed in any case.

Extra entries will be accepted as per the current rules (Maximum 5 entries each in MS and WS from the State Associations and also from Institutions who are qualified to play the Team events)

All Players who are entered as extra entries have to pay Rs. 6000/-

The Technical Committee, however, reserves the right to accept any other entry duly sponsored by a State Association.

OTHER INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES

Online Entries: All entries have to be submitted on line through the ttfi web site. If you have new players to be added to the data base, please key in their details and obtain TTFI ID before entering the entries in the on line system

Doubles Only pairs complete with names of both the players will be admitted to the draw.

Seeding In Open Events the first two names or pairs will be drawn in opposite halves of the draw, the next two names or pairs will be drawn into separate quarters and where desired up to eight entries from 5 to 8 can be drawn into separate quarters. Seeding shall be made as per the latest classification list and as per TTFI

Rules.

General Only those players who are registered with TTFI for the year 2021 are eligible to play in the Championships.

Please note that entries will be accepted only through online entry system. No entries will be accepted through any other mode of communication

INFORMATION FOR PLAYERS

By entering the event, players agree to abide by all TTFI rules and by the rules and regulations of the Organizing Committee. All entered associations and individual players agree to be under the auspices of the TTFI and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, internet, webcasting, motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind.
