RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Only registered players of the TTFI for the year 2021 can participate in the Championships;
2. All the matches will be played in accordance with the rules and regulations for National Ranking Championship as adopted by TTFI.
3. All matches will be held under the COVID 19 protocol. For details please see the attached SOP for the Championships. All players and officials should have taken the **COVID RT PCR TEST and should carry negative reports with them**, with in 72 hours before their arrival at Panchkula.
4. The Youth Boys & Girls (U-19) events open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2003.
5. For evidence of age, players should bring Original Date of Birth Certificate issued by Municipal Corporation/school so that it could be verified, if required to do so.
6. All players will have to make their own arrangement for Boarding/Lodging.
7. The decision of Tournament Committee shall be final in all matters concerned with the Championships.
8. The Tentative Schedule will be as follows:

Day 3	20th October	M/W Main draw/R 32/R 16/ QF /YBS/YGSQlfn/YBS MD
Day 4	21st October	M/W Semi finals/ Final- YGS/YBS Main Draw upto Preqr
Day 5	22nd October	YBS/YGS QF/SF/Final

(Please note that this is only a tentative schedule and CM has the final authority to change the schedule based on the final entries in consultation with OC)

9. Entries close at 12 Noon on 3rd October, for Institutions and at 12 Noon on 6th October, for the State Associations
10. The draw for seeded players shall take place on 16th October at 18:00 Hrs at Venue.
11. The maximum number of entries which an affiliated unit is allowed is as per the TTFI Guidelines. The winner/Runner up in the last nationals of the respective events: 12 entries, Losing Semi-Finalist Teams – 10 entries each, The teams placed 5th to 8th – 9 entries each and Rest of the associations 8 entries each for all events. Please note that the first 5 entries of Men and Women, and First 4 entries for the rest of the events will be with normal entry fee and the balance entries with extra entry fees. TTFI can field wild card entries (max 32)

12. STAG Americas Tables and STAG 40 + balls will be used for the Championships

13. All official Communication/Draw shall be displayed at the venue on 17th October and that alone shall be the official communication in all respects. This Championship will be treated as Ranking Tournament and Points shall be awarded as per TTFI guidelines.
14. **On Line Entries:** Entries have to be submitted on line in our web site tffi.org on the event page. Each State Association/Institution has already been provided with a Username and Password, which may be used to log in to the Online Entry System. No entries will be accepted through mail or any other communication. No entries can be permitted after the deadline.
15. With regard to any clarification regarding online entries, States/Institutions may kindly contact our Competition Manager on his mail id: competition@tffi.org or to Federation office at: tffi@tffi.org
16. All the participant players should have registered with TTFI. Entries of unregistered players will not be accepted. Players, who are already registered with TTFI, should pay a registration fee of Rs 500/- for the year 2021. Players who are registering for the first time should pay a Registration fee of Rs 1000/- This may be paid along with the entry fees in the first tournament they play in the calendar year or pay in cash at the venue. The Registration forms along with Cash should be submitted to the Competition Manager/Referee at the Venue. All Youth category (U 19 Juniors) players should submit their Date of Birth Certificates and keep originals in possession for verification.
17. Transfer of players from one state to another is allowed only before the start of the season. Once registered with a particular State, the players will not be given any transfer during the Season

19. State Associations are allowed to enter extra entries as per clause 11 above. **The entry fee for extra entries is Rs. 3500/- for Seniors, Youth**
20. **Payment of Entry Fees: on 6th October, after closure of entries, Federation office will raise an invoice to the respective associations/Institutions with regard to the payment of entry fees for all the players participating from the respective State Associations/Institutions. On receipt of the invoice the respective state Association/Institutions may transfer the amount by NEFT to the account of the organizers, which is furnished below. No entry fee may be send to TTFI office.**

21. SPORT CANCELLATION/CHANGE IN NOMINATIONS

Cancellation of participation is possible till 12:00 Noon of **16th October, 2021** After this deadline, the penalty policy will apply and no changes will be accepted on players' entries and such players will be deducted with 20 points from the ranking. In case cancellation is not possible through the online system, due to some reasons, the same may be intimated to the Competition Manager before the deadline. However the entry fees for all entries as on the date of closure of entries (03rd Oct 2021 for Institution and 06th Oct 2021 for State Association) has to be paid to the organizers

24. PLAYING SYSTEM

As per the decision of the AGM. Men Singles top 16 Players and for the rest of the events top 8 Players will be directly drawn to the Main Draw. The rest of the players will be divided into groups of 3 or 4. In all the events one player qualify from the Groups to the Main Draw. The open draw of the seeds will be held at 18:00 Hrs on 16th October, at the Venue. The draw will be done by the Referee under the supervision of the Competition Manager/Technical Committee.

- Opening Ceremony
- Media interviews
- Award Ceremonies (in full tracksuit and sport shoes)
