RULES & REGULATIONS

1. ENTRY FEES

- a) Team Entry Fee : Rs. 3000/- (for both events together)
- b) Maximum permitted entries in Singles : U 11 – Two entries (No entry fee for singles)
U 13 - Four entries (No entry fee for singles)
U 15 - Four entries (No entry fee for Singles)
- c) Extra Entry fees : Under 13 and 15 : Rs 4000/- per entry
: Under 11 : Rs 2500/-
- d) Registration fee for 2021 (Renewal) : Rs 500/- for each player
- e) Registration fee for newly registered players : Rs 1000/- for each player

- a) Sub Junior Boys Team (U 15)
- b) Sub Junior Girls Team (U 15)
- c) Sub Junior Boys Singles (U 15)
- d) Sub Junior Girls Singles (U 15)
- e) Cadet Boys Singles (U13)
- f) Cadet Girls Singles (U 13)
- g) Hopes Boys Singles (U 11)
- h) Hopes Girls Singles (U 11)

System of Play:-

- a) Team Events (Sub Junior Boys and Girls)
Corbollian Cup Format – A Team consists of 2, 3 or 4 Players.
The Team Events will be best of 5 matches i.e. 4 Singles and 1 Doubles. The order of play shall be:-
A Vs X
B Vs Y
Doubles
A Vs Y
B Vs X

The Competition shall be conducted in two stages:-

STAGE-1 All the Teams shall be drawn into Eight Groups as per the last National position and play one another in a Round Robin league System to determine the position in each group.

STAGE-II In the Second stage, the No.1 & 2 Teams of these Eight Groups shall play by knock out system, to determine the medal winners

All matches in the team championships will be decided by Best of 5 games

All the singles events shall be played in two stages

Stage-I All the players (except top 8 ranked players in Sub Junior Boys (U 15) and Sub Junior Girls (U 15) shall be divided into groups, with 3 or 4 players in each group. They shall play one another in a Round Robin league System to determine an order of position in each group. All the group league matches will be best of five games. The top 8 ranked players in U 15 will directly play the second stage.

Stage-II players in the first position from different groups (and the top eight ranked players in the Sub Junior Boys and Girls Singles) shall play according to single knock out System. All matches in stage II shall be best of five games, except semi-finals & finals in cadet events and Quarter finals and onward in Sub-Junior Singles which will be played best of seven games.

U 11- All matches in groups and Main Draw will be decided by best of 5 Games

U 13 - All matches in Groups Best of 5 games. Main Draw Knock out all matches Best of 5 games except Semi Finals and Finals which will be played on Best of 7 Games.

U- 15 - All matches in Groups Best of 5 games. Main Draw Knock out all matches Best of 5 games except, Quarter Finals, Semi Finals and Finals which will be played on Best of 7 Games.

16-Jan U 15 Boys Team Events Stage I Groups - , U 11 Boys Qlfn and KO

17-Jan U 15 Boys Team events II stage upto Finals. U 11 Boys upto finals- U 13 QLFN

18-Jan U 15 Boys Qualification, U 13 KO , U 15 KO upto Quarter Finals

19-Jan U 15 / U 13 QF, SF, Finals

(Cadet/Sub Junior Girls should report on 10th January & Cadet/ Sub Junior Boys should report on 15th January)

3. The following shall be entitled to subsidized hospitality.

Each Association shall pay a sum of Rs.400/- per day for each player, one Manager, One coach

4.. Hospitality will include:

a) Accommodation at a place provided by the host Association and

b) Boarding for Cadet/Sub Jr Girls/U11 : from Lunch 10th January to the breakfast on 15th January

c) Boarding for Cadet/Sub Jr Boys/U11 : from Lunch 15th January to the breakfast on 20th January

d) Boarding shall include Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner. All other Charges will be extra and shall be borne by the participants

5. If the accommodation place is far away more than 1 KM, the hosts will provide necessary transport from Hotel to Stadium and back.
6. There may be Three Sessions of play every day.
7. Entitlement of Entries:
Each State Association can send a maximum of 4 entries each in the Cadet Boys, Cadet Girls, Sub Junior Boys and Sub Junior Girls Events.and Two entries in Hopes (U 11).

TTFI can have 32 wild card entries, if required, as per the decision of the AGM
8. All Umpiring will be in English.
9. All events will be held under the Rules & appropriate Regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation as adopted by the Table Tennis Federation of India.
10. STAG Americas Tables and GKI plastic 40 + Balls will be used in the Championships except for Sub Juniors for which STAG Balls will be used.
- 11.. All matches will be held under the COVID 19 protocol. For details please see the attached SOP for the Championships. All players and officials should have taken the **COVID RT PCR TEST and should carry negative reports with them**, 72 hours before their arrival at Indore
12. **The closing date for receipt of entries online is 2nd January, 2022**
13. **The draws will be held on 10th January commencing at 10 A.M. at the Venue. Each Association from which entries have been received is entitled to be represented by one person duly authorized by the Association concerned. The Technical Committee will conduct the Draws.**
14. Entries will be accepted only through Affiliated Associations of the Table Tennis Federation of India. Direct entries from individual players will not be accepted.
15. Entries will not be accepted from such of those Association / Institutions who have not:-
 - a) Complied with the Rules and Regulations of TTFI in respect of affiliation fee
 - b) Paid all the arrears and complied with the decisions of the General Council of the TTFI held in previous years
16. All Associations will intimate to the Organizing Secretary the date, time and Train/Bus by which they will be reaching Indore
17. Gluing and smoking is not allowed inside the hall.
18. Participation Certificates will be given to all the participants in the 83rd Cadet and Sub Junior National Table Tennis Championships 2021
19. Parents will not be allowed to stay with the players .

OTHER INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES

Online Entry: All entries have to be submitted on line through the TTFI website. If you have new players to be added to the data base, please key in their details and obtain TTFI ID before entering the entries in the on line system

Sub-Junior Boys & Sub-Junior Girls Events (Under 15)

These events shall be open to only those players who are born on or after 01.01.2007

Cadet Boys & Cadet Girls Events (Under 13)

These events shall be open to only those players who are born on or after 01.01.2009.

Cadet Boys & Cadet Girls Events (Under 11)

These events shall be open to only those players who are born on or after 01.01.2011

Age Eligibility The respective affiliated Association shall certify the correctness of date of birth of each entrant in the Eligibility form and also submit a valid certificate of age issued by the Corporation/Municipality, failing which players will not be permitted to play.

Registration Form: All players should submit their Registration form (if no submitted earlier to TTFI this year) as per enclosed format and the same should be duly attested by the Head of the Institution/School in which the player is studying and counter Signed by the respective State Association secretary. The copy of the birth certificate should be attested by the State Secretary. In case the Registration is not within one year, a court order may be obtained after submitting the relevant documents to the Hon'ble court

Please note that entries will be accepted only through online entry system. No entries will be accepted through any other mode of communication

INFORMATION FOR PLAYERS

By entering the event, players agree to abide by all TTFI rules and by the rules and regulations of the Organizing Committee. All entered associations and individual players agree to be under the auspices of the TTFI and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, internet, webcasting, motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind.
