- 1. AUTHORITY: TTFI (Table Tennis Federation of India)
- 2. DATE AND PLACE: 14th to 17th March, 2023 at Abhay Prashal, Indore, M.P.

 3. EVENTS: The following events will be played: Men singles (Class 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10) Women singles (Class 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10) Note 1: Depending on the entries, the organizers and the Technical Delegate reserve the right to combine classes as may be necessary.

4. SCHEDULE:

Classification of New players (NON CLASSIFIED) :

Classification	: 14 th March 2023 Morning 8.00 AM
Arrival of classified Players	: 14 th March 2023 on or after 12 pm
Competition Days	: 15 th to 17th March 2023.

5. RULES: The event will be conducted in accordance with the current Laws of Table Tennis , the Regulations for International Competitions and specific IPTTC/TTFI directives as adopted by TTFI.

8. CLASSIFICATION

All new players and existing players who are to have their classification reviewed should be present in time for classification. This means that all players needing classification should arrive one day prior to competition day so that they can be classified .

NOTE :- on competition day there would be observation only and no new classification will be entertained. *This is very important and if players don't present on time they may not be classified.*

All new players should be present in time for classification on 14th March, 2023. All players should bring with them their medical diagnosis and any other medical information relevant to their classification. They should report to the classification with these documents, dressed as if they are going to play a match and with all their table tennis equipment including sports chairs. All players and support staff are expected to cooperate fully in the classification process.

09. ENTRY PROCESS

- 1. All the entries should be submitted through App "Basicx Sport" download from Google Play Store. All entries will be accepted through Basicx Sport App only. before the stipulated date and no spot entries will be entertained strictly.
- 2. All the players who have been classified need to get an xerox of the Classification card to confirm there classification.
- 3. The last date of entry will be 12th March, 2023 till 05.30 PM

10. SYSTEM OF PLAY

Singles Events: the first stage will be played in a round-robin basis in groups of even numbered players but there shall not be less than 3 and not more than 5 players in a group and priority will be given to groups of 4 players. If there are 5 or less players, the event will be played as a round-robin without knock-out.

Two players advance from each group to the second stage which will be played in a knock-out format.

The above format can be changed by TTFI as and when required to suit and match timings if necessary.

11. TECHNICAL MEETING

The technical meeting will be held on the match day prior to starting the tournament and draws will be made on the tournament day. Seeding for all the events will be done according to the International Ranking & Previous Para TT National at the time of the draws.



12. TECHNICAL OBLIGATIONS

All players entered will be bounded by the ITTF,TTFI, SAI and Classification policies and procedures during the event. Similarly, it is the responsibility of the player or team member to ensure that he or she has adequate medical, travel and other appropriate insurance.

By entering the event, all participants agree to abide by all ITTF/TTFI rules and by the rules and regulations of the organizers. All teams and individual players agree to abide by the rulings of the ITTF/TTFI and SAI. Any participant, when called upon, must appear promptly to matches or classification and follow the procedures set by the TTFI, SAI and the organizers.
