## RULES & REGULATIONS

### 1. ENTRY FEES

- a) State Associations/PSPBA : Rs 400/- for each singles entry (Max 4 entries in each category)
- b) Registration fee for 2020 : Rs 500/- for each player

### 2. Events

- a) Only Singles events will be conducted.

All the singles events shall be played in two stages

Stage-I All the players (except top 8 ranked players in Sub-Junior Boys and Sub Junior Girls) shall be divided into groups, with 3 or 4 players in each group. They shall play one another in a Round Robin league System to determine an order of position in each group. All the group league matches will be best of five games.

Stage-II Players in the first position from different groups (and the top eight ranked players in the Sub- Junior Boys and Girls Singles) shall play according to single knock out System. All matches in stage II shall be best of five games, except semi-finals & finals in cadet events and Quarter finals and onward in Sub-Junior Singles which will be played best of seven games.

- b) The schedule of play is planned as below and may be altered if found necessary.

- i) Cadet /Sub Junior Girls Singles 26<sup>th</sup> February to 1<sup>st</sup> March,2021
- ii) Cadet/Sub Junior Boys Singles 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> March, 2021

(Cadet/Sub Junior Girls should report on 25<sup>th</sup> February & Cadet/Sub Junior Boys should report on 2<sup>nd</sup> March)

- 3. The following shall be entitled to subsidized hospitality.

Each Association shall pay a sum of Rs. 400/- per day for each player, one Manager, One coach

- 4. Hospitality will include:

- a) Accommodation at a place provided by the Federation and
- b) Boarding for Cadet/Sub Jr Girls : from Lunch 25<sup>th</sup> Feb to the breakfast on 2<sup>nd</sup> March
- c) Boarding for Cadet/Sub Jr Boys : from lunch 2<sup>nd</sup> March to the breakfast on 7<sup>th</sup> March
- d) Boarding shall include Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner. All other Charges will be extra and shall be borne by the participants

- 5. If the accommodation place is far away more than 1 KM, the hosts will provide necessary transport from Hotel to Stadium and back.

- 6. There may be Three Sessions of play every day.

- 7. **Entitlement of Entries:** Each State Association can send a maximum of 4 entries each in the Cadet Boys, Cadet Girls, Sub-Junior Boys and Sub-Junior Girls Events. There shall be no extra entries. PSPBA can send a maximum of 4 entries each in Cadet Boys and Sub-Junior Boys ONLY.

TTFI can have 16 wild card entries, if required, as per the decision of the AGM

Players whose age is below 10 years will not be allowed to play in the Nationals as per COVID-19 protocol. State Associations should not enter any player below the age of 10 years for any event.

8. All umpiring will be in English.
9. All events will be held under the Rules & appropriate Regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation as adopted by the Table Tennis Federation of India.
10. STAG Americas Tables and GKI plastic 40 + Balls will be used in the Championships
11. All matches will be held under the COVID-19 protocol. For details please see the attached SOP for the Championships. All players and officials should have taken the **COVID RT-PCR TEST and should carry negative reports with them**, 72 hours before their arrival at Indore
12. **The closing date for receipt of entries online is 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2021**
13. **The draws will be held on 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2021 commencing at 10 A.M. at the Venue of the Senior National at Punchkula. Each Association from which entries have been received is entitled to be represented by one person duly authorized by the Association concerned. The Technical Committee will conduct the Draws.**
14. Entries will be accepted only through Affiliated Associations of the Table Tennis Federation of India. Direct entries from individual players will not be accepted.
15. Entries will not be accepted from such of those Associations/Institutions who have not:-
  - a) Complied with the Rules and Regulations of TTFI in respect of affiliation fee
  - b) Paid all the arrears and complied with the decisions of the General Council of the TTFI held in previous years
16. All Associations will intimate to the Organizing Secretary at least 10 days before the commencement of the Championships, the date, time and Train/Bus by which they will be reaching Indore
17. Gluing and smoking is not allowed inside the hall.
18. Participation Certificates will be given to all the participants in the 82nd Cadet and Sub-Junior National Table Tennis Championships 2020
19. Parents will not be allowed to stay with the players.

## **OTHER INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES**

Online Entry: All entries have to be submitted on line through the TTFI website. If you have new players to be added to the data base, please key in their details and obtain TTFI ID before entering the entries in the on line system

### **Sub-Junior Boys & Sub-Junior Girls Events**

These events shall be open to only those players who are born on or after 01.01.2006

### **Cadet Boys & Cadet Girls Events**

These events shall be open to only those players who are born on or after 01.01.2009.

**Age Eligibility:** The respective affiliated Association shall certify the correctness of date of birth of each entrant in the Eligibility form and also submit a valid certificate of age issued by the Corporation/Municipality, failing which players will not be permitted to play.

**Registration Form:** All players should submit their Registration form (if not submitted earlier to TTFI this year) as per enclosed format and the same should be duly attested by the Head of the Institution/School in which the player is studying and counter-signed by the respective State Association secretary. The copy of the birth certificate should be attested by the State Secretary.

In case the Registration is not within one year, a court order may be obtained after submitting the relevant documents to the Hon'ble Court

**Please note that entries will be accepted only through online entry system. No entries will be accepted through any other mode of communication.**

## **INFORMATION FOR PLAYERS**

By entering the event, players agree to abide by all TTFI rules and by the rules and regulations of the Organizing Committee. All entered associations and individual players agree to be under the auspices of the TTFI and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, internet, webcasting, motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. Participants release all rights or rights held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to television and webcasting coverage, video and motion picture coverage and photographic coverage of any kind.
