

RULES & REGULATI ONS

- 1. Only registered players of the TTFI for the year 2023 can participate in the Championships;
- 2. All the matches will be played in accordance with the rules and regulations for Regional Championship as adopted by TTFI;
- 3. The Youth Boys & Girls (U-19) events open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2005;
- 4. The Youth Boys & Girls (U-17 Junior) events open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2007
- 5. The Youth Boys & Girls (U-15 Sub Junior) events are open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2009
- 6. The Youth Boys & Girls (U-13 Cadet) events are open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2011
- 7. The Youth Boys & Girls (U-11) events open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2013;
- 8. For evidence of age, players should bring Original Date of Birth Certificate issued by Municipal Corporation/school so that it could be verified, if required
- 9. All players will have to make their own arrangement for Boarding/Lodging;
- 10. The decision of Tournament Committee shall be final in all matters concerned with the Championships;
- 11. The Tentative Schedule will be as follows:

Day 1	8 th December	U 11/U 13 Qualification, U 11 main draw up to PQF
Day 2	9 th December	U 11 QF/SF/F, U 13 up to PQF, U 15 Qualifications
Day 3	10 th December	U 13 QF/SF/F, U 15 main draw up to PQF, U 17 Qualifications
Day 4	11 th December	U 15 QF/SF/F. U 17 up to PQF, U 19, Seniors Qualifications
Day 5	12 th December	U 17 QF/SF/F, MS/WS up to R/32, U 19 up to R/32, XD up to PQF
Day 6	13 th December	U 19 PQF/QF/SF/F, MS/WS PQF/QF, XD QF/SF/F
Day 7	14 th December	MS/WS: SF/Finals

(Please note that this is only a tentative schedule and CM has the final authority to change the schedule based on the final entries in consultation with OC)

- 12. Entries close at 12 Noon on 23rd November for Institutions and at 12 Noon on 25th November for the State Associations.
- 13. DRAW FOR FIRST STAGE OF ALL EVENTS AT 15:00 Hrs on 7th December, 2023 at Venue.
- 14. DRAW FOR SEEDED PLAYERS AT 18:00 Hrs on 7th December, 2023 at Venue.

15. Normal and Extra Entries:

Men/Women – 5 Entries with normal entry fee and additional with extra entry fees; For Institutions – 2 Entries with normal entry fee and additional with extra entry fees; Other events- 4 Entries with normal entry fee and additional with extra entry fees; **Mixed Doubles**: The maximum entries per state are restricted to two. Institutions are eligible to send only one entry in Mixed Doubles. We are also allowing the players to pair up with players from other states. However, such entries should come from both states. Players who are under the age of 17 are not eligible to participate in the event unless they are ranked within the top 16 in Men and Women, ranked within the top 8 in the U-19 category, or are in the top 5 in their respective states in Men/Women.

TTFI can field wild card entries (Max 32) in each event and they will be treated as extra entries with the fees applicable for the events.

- 16. Equipment: STAG Americas Tables will be used for the Tournament. STAG 40+ plastic balls will be used for all events, except for Men and Women which will be played with DHS DJ 40+ balls.
- 17. All official Communication/Draw shall be displayed at the venue on 7th December, 2023 and that alone shall be the official communication in all respects. This Championship will be treated as Ranking Tournament and Points shall be awarded as per TTFI guidelines.
- 18. **On Line Entries**: Entries have to be submitted on line in our web site ttfi.org on the event page. Each State Association/Institution has already been provided with a Username and Password, which may be used to log in to the Online Entry System No entries will be accepted through mail or any other communication. No entries can be permitted after the deadline.
- 19. With regard to any clarification regarding online entries, States/Institutions may kindly contact our Federation office at:domesticevent@ttfi.org
- 20. All the players should have registered with TTFI. Entries of unregistered players will not be accepted. Players, who are already registered with TTFI, should pay a registration fee of Rs 500/-for the year 2023. Players who are registering for the first time should pay a Registration fee of Rs 1000/- This may be paid along with the entry fees in the first tournament they play in the calendar year All Youth category (U 19 Juniors) players should submit their Date of Birth Certificates and keep originals in possession for verification.
- 21. Transfer of players from one state to another is allowed only before the start of the season. Once registered with a particular State, the players will not be given any transfer during the Season.

22. The entry fee will be as follows

First five entries in Men, Women First four entries in U-19, U 17 First four entries in U -15, U-13 First four entries in U - 11 Mixed Doubles : Rs. 900/- each : Rs. 800/- each : Rs. 700/- each ; Rs 600/- each : Rs. 1800/- per pair

23. State Associations are allowed to enter extra entries as per clause 15 above. **The entry fee for extra entries will be as follows:-**

Seniors/U19/U17	- Rs 3500/-
U 15/U13	- Rs 2500/-
U 11	- Rs 1500/-

24. Payment of Entry Fees: The entry fees have to be paid online. The system will itself generate an invoice and the State Associations/Institutions should pay the same. Unless the entry fees are paid, the entries will not reflect in the system of entries for the respective events. Hence, all state associations have to pay the entry fees before the entry closure deadline. Otherwise, their entries will not be entered for the Championships. No entry fee may be paid to the TTFI office or any other account other than the online payment.

25. SPORT CANCELLATION/CHANGE IN NOMINATIONS

Cancellation of participation is possible till 12:00 Noon of 27th November, 2023. After this deadline, the penalty policy will apply and no changes will be accepted on players' entries and such players will be deducted with 20 points from the ranking. In case cancellation is not possible through the online system, due to some reasons, the same may be intimated to the Competition Manager before the deadline. However the entry fees for all entries as on the date of closure of entries (26th November) has to be paid to the organizers.

By entering the event, players agree to abide by all TTFI rules and by the rules and regulations of the Organizing Committee. Participants release all rights or rights held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to television and webcasting coverage, video and motion picture coverage and photographic coverage of any kind. A participant's refusal of above listed coverage may attract suspension or dismissal from the competition.

28. PLAYING SYSTEM

Direct to the Main Draw

Men's Singles: Top 16 Ranked Players

All other events (except YS under 11): Top 8 Ranked players

The rest of the players will be divided into groups of 3 or 4. In all the events one player qualifies from each Group to the Main Draw. Mixed Doubles event will be held on a knock-out basis. The draw will be done by the Referee under the supervision of the Competition Manager/Technical Committee.

29. PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES

Athletes are expected to attend the following promotional activities:

- Opening Ceremony
- Media interviews
- Award Ceremonies (in full tracksuit and sport shoes)

Failure to participate in promotional activities may result in loss of prize money and medals or both.
