### **RULES & REGULATIONS**

#### **ENTRY FEES**

a) State Associations : Rs 500/- for each singles entry (Max 4 entries in each category)

b) Registration fee for 2021 : Rs 500/- for each player

#### 2. **Events**

a) The following events will be conducted:

1. Youth Boys Singles Under-19

2. Youth Girls Singles Under-19

3. Youth Boys Singles Under-17

4. Youth Girls Singles Under-17

b) Only Singles events will be conducted. There will be no Team or Doubles events.

All the singles events will be played in two stages:

Stage-I: All the players (except the top-eight ranked players in YBS U19, YGS U19, YBS U17, YGS U17)) will be divided into groups of 3 or 4 players in each group. They will play one another in a round-robin league format to determine the order of position in each group. All the group league matches will be of best of five games.

Stage-II: Players finishing in the first position in each group, and the top-eight ranked players in the YBS U19, YGS U19, YBS U17, YGS U17 will play according to the single knockout system. All the Stage II matches will be of best of five games, except the following rounds that will be of best of seven games.

Quarterfinals onwards in YBS U17, YGS U17;

Pre-quarterfinals onwards in YBS U19, YGS U 19.

c) The schedule of play is planned as below, and may be altered, if necessary.

17<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 i) Youth Girls Singles Under 17 & 19

21st to 23rd June, 2022 ii) Youth Boys Singles Under 17 & 19

Girls under 17 & 19 should report on 16<sup>th</sup> June and the Boys Under 17 & 19 on 20<sup>th</sup> June

3. The following are entitled to subsidised hospitality.

Each state association will pay a sum of Rs.400/- per day for each player, one manager, one coach and the maximum people eligible for subsidized hospitality are 18, including one manager and one coach. The hospitality charges for additional manager/coach would be Rs. 750 per pax, per day.

- 4 Hospitality will include:
  - a) Accommodation at a place provided by the host association, and Boarding for Girls from Lunch 16<sup>th</sup> June to breakfast on 20<sup>th</sup> June; Boarding for Boys from Lunch 20<sup>th</sup> June to breakfast on 24<sup>th</sup> June.
  - b) Boarding shall include Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner. All other charges levied will be extra and to be borne by the participants.
- 5. If the accommodation provided is far away and more than a kilometer, the hosts will make transport from Hotel to Stadium and back.
- 6. There may be three sessions of play possible every day.
- 7. Entitlement of entries:

Each state association can send a maximum of FOUR entries each of the Youth Boys Singles U19 and U17, and Youth Girls Singles U19 and U17.

**Extra Entries**: Each state association is entitled to FOUR extra entries in each of the categories. The players who are entered as extra entries should be within the top-16 ranks in their respective state in each of those categories.

The Extra Entry fee will be Rs. 4000/- per entry in Youth Girls/Boys Under-17, while it will be Rs 6000/- per entry in Youth Girls/Boys Under-19.

TTFI can consider 16 wild card entries, if and when required.

- 8. All the events will be held under the rules & regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation and as adopted by the Table Tennis Federation of India.
- 9. STAG Americas Tables and STAG balls will be used in the Championships.
- 10.. The closing date for receipt of entries online is 31st May, 2022.
- 11. The draws will be held electronically on 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 commencing at 10 a.m. at New Delhi. The Technical Committee will conduct the draws.
- Entries will be accepted only through an affiliated unit of the Table Tennis Federation of India. Direct entries from individual players will not be entertained.
- 13. All the associations/institutions will inform the Organizing Secretary at least 10 days before the commencement of the championships the date, time and the mode of transport by which their teams will be arriving at Alappuzha.
- 14. Gluing and smoking is not allowed inside the hall.
- 15. Participation certificates will be issued to all the participants of the 83<sup>rd</sup> Junior & Youth National Table Tennis Championships-2021. Those who make it to the medal rounds will get merit certificates.

Online Entry: All entries have to be submitted online through the TTFI website portal. If new players are to be added to the data base, please key in the details and obtain the TTFI ID before entering the names in the online portal.								
Youth Boys & Youth Girls Events (Under 19) These events are open to only those players who are born on or after 01.01.2003								
Junior Boys & Junior Girls Events (Under 17) These events are open to only those players who are born on or after 01.01.2005.								
Age Eligibility Registration Form:	The respective affiliated units shall certify the correctness of the date of birth of each entrant and all players should submit their registration form (if not submitted earlier to TTFI this year) In the prescribed format, duly attested by the Head of the Institution/School in which the player is studying and counter-signed by the respective State Association secretary. The copy of the birth certificate should also be attested by the State Secretary. In case the birth registration is not done within a year with the authorities concerned, a court order has to be obtained.							
INFORMATION FO	R PLAYERS							
By entering the event, players agree to abide by all TTFI rules and regulations, including that of the Organizing Committee.
