RULES & REGULATIONS

1. ENTRY FEES

- a) State Associations/PSPB/RSPB : Rs 500/- for each singles entry (Max MS 5 & WS 5 entries each)
- b) Other Institutions
- c) Registration fee for 2020
- : Rs500/- for each singles entry (Max MS 2 & WS 2 entries each) : Rs 500/- for each player

2. Events

a) Only Singles events will be conducted. No Team or Doubles events

All the singles events shall be played in two stages

Stage I In the first stage, all the players except 1- 16 classified/ranked players shall be divided into groups, with 3 or 4 players in each group. They shall play one another in a Round Robin League System to determine an order of position in each group. All the Group league matches will be best of five games. The winner from each group shall qualify to the Main Draw

Stage II In the second stage, the winners from each groups & Classified/Ranked Players 1- 16 shall play according to single knock out system. All matches in stage II shall be best of seven games.

- b) The schedule of play is planned as below and may be altered if found necessary.
- i) Women's Singles 15 18 February, 2021
- ii) Men's Singles 20 23 February, 2021

(Women Players should report on 14th February and can leave on 19th February. Men players should report on 19th February and you have to leave before 24th February)

3. The following shall be entitled to subsidized hospitality.

Each Association shall pay a sum of Rs.450/- per day for each player, one Manager, One coach

- 4. Hospitality will include:
 - a) Accommodation at a place provided by the Federation and Boarding from Lunch of 14th February up to the breakfast on 19th February for the Women's Players

For the Men players' hospitality starts from the Lunch of 19th February up to the breakfast of 24th February, 2021. Men players need to arrive only on 19th February and you have to leave before 24th February.

- b) Boarding shall include Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner. All other Charges will be extra and shall be borne by the participants
- 5. If the accommodation place is far away more than 1 KM, the hosts will provide necessary transport from Hotel to Stadium and back.
- 6. There may be Three Sessions of play every day.

7. Entitlement of Entries:

Each State Association can send a maximum of 5 entries each in the Men's and Women's Singles. There shall be no extra entries. PSPB and RSPB are treated at par with the State Associations and they can send 5 entries each in the Men's and Women's Singles.

All affiliated Institutions are entitled for 2 entries each in the Men's and Women's Singles. No additional entries will be accepted

TTFI can have 16 wild card entries, if required, as per the decision of the AGM

- 8. All Umpiring will be in English.
- 9. All events will be held under the Rules & appropriate Regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation as adopted by the Table Tennis Federation of India.
- 10. STAG Americas Table sand STAG plastic 40 + Balls will be used in the Championships
- 11.. All matches will be held under the COVID 19 protocol. For details please see the attached SOP for the Championships. All players and officials should have taken the COVID RT PCR TEST and should carry negative reports with them, 72 hours before their arrival at Panchkula.
- 12. The closing date for receipt of entries online is 5th February, 2021
- 13. The draws will be held on 10th February, 2021 commencing at 10 A.M. at the Federation office, New Delhi. Each Association from which entries have been received is entitled to be represented by one person duly authorized by the Association concerned. The Technical Committee will conduct the Draws.
- 14 Entries will be accepted only through Affiliated Associations / Institutions of the Table Tennis Federation of India. Direct entries from individual players will not be accepted.
- 15. Entries will not be accepted from such of those Association / Institutions who have not:a) Complied with the Rules and Regulations of TTFI in respect of affiliation fee
 b)Paid all the arrears and complied with the decisions of the General Council of the TTFI held in previous years
- 16. All Associations / Institutions will intimate to the Organizing Secretary at least 10 days before the commencement of the Championships, the date, time and Train/Bus by which they will be reaching Panchkula.
- 17. Gluing and smoking is not allowed inside the hall.
- 18. Participation Certificates will be given to all the participants in the 82nd Senior National Table Tennis Championships 2020.

OTHER INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES

Online Entry: All entries have to be submitted on line through the TTFI website. If you have new players to be added to the data base, please key in their details and obtain TTFI ID before entering the entries in the on line system

- Seeding The entry ranked 1 shall be placed at the top of the first half of the draw and the entry ranked 2 at the bottom of the second half, but all other seeded entries shall be drawn among specified places in the draw, as follows: The entries ranked 3 and 4 shall be drawn between the bottom of the first half of the draw and the top of the second half; the entries ranked 5-8 shall be drawn among the bottom places of the odd numbered quarters of the draw and the top places of the even numbered quarters and so on. Seeding shall be made as
- **General** Only those players who are registered with TTFI for the year 2020 are eligible to play in the Championships.

Please note that entries will be accepted only through online entry system. No entries will be accepted through any other mode of communication
