RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Only registered players of the TTFI for the year 2019 can participate in the Championships.
2. All the matches will be played in accordance with the rules and regulations for Regional Championship as adopted by TTFI.
3. The Youth Boys & Girls event shall be open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.1999.
4. The Junior Boys and Girls event shall be open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2002.
5. The Sub-Junior Boys and Girls event shall be open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2005.
6. **New Events:** Boys singles/Girls Singles (13 – 15 yrs). This new event will be conducted as per the directions of Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, GOI. This event is open for all boys and girls from the Central Zone states (VIZ: Chhattisgarh, Daman & Diu, Goa, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra) who have completed 13 years and are below 15 years. Since this is an open event, there is no restriction in the number of entries from the states of this region.
*(Some of the West Zone states have been included to make it a six-team affair, the minimum requirement, so that all states get the opportunity).
7. The Cadet Boys and Girls event shall be open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2008.
8. For evidence of age, players should bring Original Date of Birth Certificate issued by Municipal Corporation/school so that it could be verified, if required to do so.
9. All players will have to make their own arrangement for Lodging.
10. The decision of Tournament Committee shall be final in all matters connected with the Championships.
11. The Tentative Schedule will be as follows:

Day 5	11th Nov	MS/WS- SF/Finals/Youth MD/Junior MD/ Boys/Girls 13-15 (Knockout)/MXD QF/SF/Final
Day 6	12th Nov	Youth SF/Finals, Junior MD, SF/Finals/ Sub-Junior Qualifications
Day 7	13th Nov	Cadet/Sub-Junior Qualifications/Main Draw
Day 8	14th Nov	Sub-Juniors/Cadets QF/SF/Finals

(Please note that this is only a tentative schedule and CM has the final authority to change the schedule based on the final entries in consultation with OC).

12. Entries close at 12 Noon on 1st October for Institutions and at 12 Noon on 6th October for the State Associations
13. The draw for seeded players shall take place on 7th November at 18:00 Hrs at Venue.
14. The maximum number of entries which an affiliated unit is allowed is as per the TTFI Guidelines. The winner/Runner up in the last nationals of the respective events: 12 entries, the third placed Teams – 10 entries, The teams placed 5th – 9 entries and Rest of the associations 8 entries for all events. Please note that the first 5 entries of Men and Women, and First 4 entries for the rest of the events will be with normal entry fee and the balance entries with extra entry fees. TTFI can field wild card entries (max 32). Institutions are eligible to send only 2 entries as per normal fees. For the Boys/Girls singles (13-15 yrs) category there is no restriction of entries from the Eastern states, schools or by Individual.
15. **STAG Tables and ITTF approved balls will be used for the Championships** (for Cadets only GKI balls will be used)
16. All official Communication/Draw shall be displayed at the venue on 7th November and that alone shall be the official communication in all respects. This Championship will be treated as Ranking Tournament and Points shall be awarded as per TTFI guidelines.
17. **On Line Entries:** Entries have to be submitted on line in our web site tffi.org on the event page. Each State Association/Institution has already been provided with a Username and Password, which may be used to log in to the Online Entry System. No entry will be accepted through mail or any other communication. No entries can be permitted after the deadline.
18. With regard to any clarification regarding online entries, States/Institutions may kindly contact our Competition Manager on his mail id: ganeshaniob@gmail.com or to Federation office at: tffi@tffi.org
19. All the participant players should have registered with TTFI. Entries of unregistered players will not be accepted. Players should pay a registration fee of Rs 500/- for the year 2019. This may be paid along with the entry fees in the first tournament they play in the calendar year or pay in cash at the venue. The Registration forms along with Cash should be submitted to the Competition Manager/Referee at the Venue. All Cadet, Sub-Junior, Junior, Youth category players should submit their Date of Birth Certificates and keep originals in possession for verification.
20. Transfer of players from one state to another is allowed only before the start of the season. Once registered with a particular State, the players will not be given any transfer during the Season
21. The entry fee will be as follows

First four entries in Cadets and Sub-Junior	: Rs. 700/- each
First four entries in Youth and juniors	: Rs. 800/- each
First five entries in Men, Women	: Rs. 900/- each
Boys/Girls Singles (13-15 years)	: Rs. 200/- each
Mixed Doubles	: Rs 500/- per pair

22. State Associations are allowed to enter extra entries as per clause 14 above. **The entry fee for extra entries is Rs. 3500/- for Seniors, Youth and Junior per player & Rs. 2500/- for Sub-Junior and Cadet**
23. **Payment of Entry Fees: on 9th October, after closure of entries, Federation office will raise an invoice to the respective associations/Institutions with regard to the payment of entry fees for all players participating from respective State Associations/Institutions. On receipt of the invoice the respective state Association/Institutions may transfer the amount by NEFT to the account of the organizers, which is furnished below. No entry fee may be sent to TTFI office.**

24. SPOT CANCELLATION/CHANGE IN NOMINATIONS

Cancellation of participation is possible till 12:00 Noon of **9th October**. After this deadline, the penalty policy will apply and no changes will be accepted on players' entries and such players will be deducted with 20 points from the ranking. In case cancellation is not possible through the online system, due to some reasons, the same may be intimated to the Competition Manager before the deadline. However the entry fees for all entries as on the date of closure of entries (9th October) has to be paid to the organizers.

26. INFORMATION FOR PLAYERS

By entering the event, players agree to abide by all TTFI rules and by the rules and regulations of the Organizing Committee. All entered associations and individual players agree to be under the auspices of the TTFI and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, internet, webcasting, motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. Participants release all rights or rights held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to television and webcasting coverage, video and motion picture coverage and photographic coverage of any kind. A participant's refusal of above listed coverage may attract suspension or dismissal from the competition.

27. PLAYING SYSTEM

As per the decision of the AGM.. Men's Singles top 16 Players and for the rest of the events top 8 Players (except Cadet Events) will be directly drawn to the Main Draw. The rest of the players will be divided into groups of 3 or 4. In all events one player qualify from the Groups to the Main Draw. The open draw of the seeds will be held at 18:00 Hrs on 7th November at the Venue. The draw will be done by the Referee under the supervision of the Competition Manager/Technical Committee.

28. PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES

Athletes are expected to attend the following promotional activities:

- Opening Ceremony
- Media interviews
- Award Ceremonies (in full tracksuit and sport shoes)

Failure to participate in promotional activities may result in loss of prize money, medals or both.

As per the decision of the AGM, it has been decided to conduct Team Championships for Men and Women for the states in the respective Zones, before commencement of the Zonal Championships. As such, Men and Women Teams Championships for the States, viz. (**Chhattisgarh, Daman & Diu, Goa, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra**) will be held at Bhavnagar. Only Team entries from these states will be accepted for the event. To provide participation in team championships, we have combined states from both West and Central zones together.

Rules and Regulations

- I. The Regulation for the competitions for Men's and Women's team events will be as followed. All individual matches in the team events will be determined by the best of 5 games.

- II. The competition shall be conducted on knockout basis.
- III The team events for both Men and Women will start at 0900 Hrs on 07th November, 2019 and will be finished on the same day.
- IV Prizes will be given to the Winners/ Runners up/Losing Semi Finalists
- V No accommodation will be provided by the organizers and it will be the responsibility of the respective States/Players to arrange their accommodation.
- VI The entries are to be submitted by the states through the online system.
- VII. Entry fees: Each team has to pay an entry fees of Rs 500/-
