- 1. AUTHORITY: Table Tennis Federation of India (through Committee of Administrators)
- 2. DATE AND PLACE: 27th to 30th April 2022 at Abhay Prashal, Indore, Madhya Pradesh.
- 3. EVENTS: The following events will be played:

Men singles (class 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10) Women singles (class 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10)

Note 1: depending on the entries, the organisers and the Technical Delegate reserve the right to combine classes as may be necessary.

4. SCHEDULE:

The arrival of New players (NON CLASSIFIED): 27th April 2022 for new players seeking

(On or before 8.00am)

Classification : 27th April 2022 Morning 8.00 AM
Arrival of classified Players : 27th April 2022 on or after 12 noon

Competition Days : 28th to 30th April 2022.

5. RULES: The event will be conducted in accordance with the current Laws of Table Tennis, the Regulations for International Competitions and specific IPTTC/TTFI directives as adopted by TTFI.

11. CLASSIFICATION

All new players and existing players who are to have their classification reviewed should be present in time for classification. This means that all players needing classification should arrive one day before competition day so that they can be classified.

NOTE:- On competition day there would be observation only and no new classification will be entertained.

This is very important when players don't present on time and may not be classified.

All new players should be present in time for classification on 27th April 2022. All players should bring with them their medical diagnosis and any other medical information relevant to their classification. They should report to the classification with these documents, dressed as if they are going to play a match and with all their table tennis equipment including sports chairs. All players and support staff are expected to cooperate fully in the classification process.

12. ENTRY PROCESS

- 2. All the players who have been classified need to get a xerox of the classification card to confirm their classification.
 - 3. The last date of entry will be 22nd April 2022

13. SYSTEM OF PLAY

Singles Events: the first stage will be played on a round-robin basis in groups of evennumbered players but there shall not be less than 3 and not more than 5 players in a group and priority will be given to groups of 4 players. If there are 5 or fewer players, the event will be played as a round-robin without knock-out. Two players advance from each group to the second stage which will be played in a knock-out format.

The above format can be changed by the tournament director as and when required to suit and match timings if necessary.

14. TECHNICAL MEETING

The technical meeting will be held on the matchday before starting the tournament and draws will be made on the tournament day.

Seeding for all the events will be done according to the Last Para TT events at the time of the draws.









15. TECHNICAL OBLIGATIONS

All players entered will be bounded by the ITTF, TTFI, SAI and Classification policies and procedures during the event. Similarly, it is the responsibility of the player or team member to ensure that he or she has adequate medical, travel and other appropriate insurance.

By entering the event, all participants agree to abide by all ITTF/TTFI rules and by the rules and regulations of the organizers. All teams and individual players agree to abide by the rulings of the ITTF/TTFI and SAI. Any participant, when called upon, must appear promptly to matches or classification and follow the procedures set by the TTFI, SAI and the organizers.

- 16. All the players / Escorts must report at the venue (Abhay Prashal) as per their event schedule along with a <u>NEGATIVE STATUS REPORT</u> of RT-PCR (COVID-19 test) 72 hours before reaching Indore, Without production of the certificate, no player/escort will be permitted entry in the stadium.
- 17. SOP issued by Govt. Of India & M.P. State Government will be followed strictly.
- 18. Boarding & Lodging will be free to all the participants (Players / Escorts) so long as they are in the Draw. To clarify further, if a player loses in the championship then he/she has to vacate the Room the next day morning by 12.00 noon
