

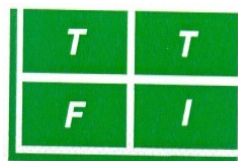

## **PROSPECTUS**

**Dates : 14 - 17 May, 2023**

### **1. AUTHORITY**

The South Asian Youth Table Tennis Championships 2023 will be organized by Table Tennis Arunachal under auspices and authority of the Asian Table Tennis Union/Table Tennis Federation of India

**2. DATE** Sunday 14 May 2023 to Wednesday 17 May 2023

**3. VENUE** Dorjee Khandu Badminton Hall  
Rajbhawan itanagar Arunachal Pradesh.

**4. EVENTS** U 19 Boys' & Girls' Teams  
U 15 Boys' & Girls' Teams  
U 19 Boys' & Girls' Singles  
U 15 Boys' & Girls' Singles  
U 19 Boys' & Girls' Doubles

**U 15 Boys' & Girls' Doubles**  
**U 19 & U 15 Mixed Doubles**

5. **SCHEDULE** **Team Events : 14 – 15 May ,2023**  
**Individual Events: 15 – 17 May, 2023**
- Draw for all events : 13 May, 2023**
6. **RULES** The Championships will be conducted in accordance with the current Laws of Table Tennis , the Regulations for International Competitions
7. **EQUIPMENT** **TABLES : STAG AMERICAS 16**  
**BALLS : STAG 40 +**  
**FLOORING: STAG**
8. **ELIGIBILITY** All racket coverings must be of type currently authorized by the ITTF  
The South Asian Youth Championships 2023 is open to Athletes satisfying the following 2 Conditions
- a) Being born in 2004 or later to participate in U19 events, being born in 2008 or later to participate in U15 events
  - b) Being eligible to represent their National Association according to rules 3.8 and 4.2.3 of the ITTF Handbook
9. **ENTRY FEES** There will be no entry fees for any of the events.
10. **ENTRIES** **U 19 Events: Each Association may nominate**
- a) Not more than 4 Players each for the Boys team and Girls team events
  - b) Not more than 2 players each for the U 19 Boys Singles and U 19 Girls Singles events
  - c) Not more than 1 pair each for Boys, Girls and Mixed Doubles.
- U 15 Events: Each Association may nominate**
- a) Not more than 3 Players each for the Boys team and Girls team events
  - b) Not more than 2 players each for the U 15 Boys Singles and U 15 Girls Singles events
  - c) Not more than 1 pairs each for Boys, Girls and Mixed Doubles.
11. **SYSTEM OF PLAY** **U 19 Boys' and Girls' Team Events**
- The competition will be held in two stages (1st Stage League and 2nd Stage Knock out)
- In case there are less than 6 teams all the teams shall play in the single round robin system. The Team events will be held on New Swaythling Cup System format.

The order of play will be as follows A vs X, B vs Y, C vs Z, A vs Y, B vs X

All matches shall be played in best of Five (5) Games.

### **U 19 Individual Events:**

The system of play will be decided with mutual consultation at the time of Draws. Doubles events will be played on knock out basis. All matches will be best of Five (5) Games.

### **U 15 Events**

#### **Team Event**

The competition will be held in two stages (1st Stage League and 2nd Stage Knock out)

In case there are less than 6 teams all the teams shall play in the single round robin system. The Team events will be held on Corbillon cup system.

The Team to be composed of 2 to 3 players: A v/s X, B v/s Y, Doubles, A v/s Y, B v/s X.

#### **Singles Event**

The system of play will be decided with mutual consultation at the time of Draws

12. **HOSPITALITY** **The Organizing Committee will provide free hospitality From the Lunch on 13<sup>th</sup> May 2023 to the Breakfast of 18<sup>th</sup> May 2023 which include the board and lodging to the following:**

- a) Not more than 6 players each in the Boys'and Girls Section
- b) Official - one Manager and one coach accompanying the teams.
- c) Total number of persons eligible for free hospitality per country is 14
- d) All member of SATTF Executive Committee.
- e) International Umpires.
- f) Secretary / President of all the Six South Asian Countries

13. **ACCOMPANYING PERSONS**

Persons other than the players and Officials listed on the Official Entry Forms and more than 14 persons (as above) per country can be accommodated at a charge of US \$ 60 per person per day in a Twin/Double room or US \$ 90 per person per day in a Single Room including Meals and Transport. The same rates apply for days covered by free hospitality.

14. **GENERAL**

- a) Each team should bring their National Flag
- b) A Colour photograph of 4cmx 3cm should accompany the final entry form with a short narration of the players' achievements and narrations of Officials to be included in the souvenir
- c) By entering the Championships, each association must ensure that all delegation members confirm that they know their personal data will be shared with the organizers and SATTF who in turn, undertake not to share it with any unauthorized person in any way.
- d) By entering the championships, all delegation members undertake to abide by the ITTF's anti-doping rules
- e) By entering the Championships, participants agree to abide by all SATTF rules and the rules and regulations of the Organizing Committee. All entered associations, players agree to be under the auspices of SATTF and its agents in all matters concerning TV coverage, video, internet web casting, motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. Participants release all rights, or rights held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to TV and web casting coverage, video and motion picture coverage and hence accept such coverage during the Championships. A participant's refusal of the above listed coverage may be subject to suspension or dismissal from the competition. Any participant, when called upon, must appear promptly to press conferences or medal presentations and follow the procedures set by the SATTF and the Organizing committee
- f) Each association must ensure that they follow the COVID 19 protocols and all members who participate in the championships are fully vaccinated and must have travel insurance for the duration of the Championships
- g) Transportation will be provided from Holongi (Itanagar) Airport to the selected hotel and Back. Free transportation will only be arranged when travel forms are received before the deadline and the players avail the official hospitality package
